In 1988 the Canadian Centre for Health and Safety in Agriculture partnered with the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities (SARM) and six Rural Municipalities, to establish the network. The mission was “to improve health and safety on the farm through education, service, and evaluation research.” Over the last 25 years, the Network has steadily increased to 219 RMs including over 27,000 Saskatchewan farm families. Watersheds



A watershed or catchment basin is the region of land that drains into a specific body of water, such as a river, lake, sea, or ocean. It is the entire geographical area characterized by all runoff being conveyed to the same outlet. There are currently 29 Watersheds in Saskatchewan whose mandate is the protection of both ground and surface water.

Regional Authority of Carlton Trail (REACT)



REACT went into operation September 3, 1996 as the first fully integrated regional solid waste management system in the province. The Federation of Canadian Municipalities in 2009 chose REACT as one of the top nine municipal entities across Canada for successful waste management diversion and partnerships. REACT received the Saskatchewan Municipal Award in 2010 for Regional Leadership and Partnerships.

Today REACT serves 31 urban and 16 rural municipalities with a population of approximately 26,000. The RM of LeRoy is one of the 47 municipalities forming REACT.

SAMA is an independent agency that provides reliable, up-to-date property assessment valuations – the pillar upon which governments set tax policy and property tax rates. SAMA does not make tax policy or set mill rates. SAMA is responsible for:

- Developing and maintaining the province's assessment policies, standards and procedures
- Auditing assessments, and reviewing and confirming municipal assessment rolls
- Providing property valuation services to local governments (municipalities)
